WHAT IS HCBS-AMH?

Home and Community-Based Services—Adult Mental Health (HCBS-AMH) helps you live in the community of your choice, supporting long-term recovery from serious mental illness.



HCBS-AMH serves those with serious mental illness who also experience extended stays in state mental health facilities, multiple arrests, or frequent Emergency Room visits. The program provides individualized resources, services, and supports to enable each program participant to successfully reintegrate into his or her community.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

QUALIFIERS

- 18 or older with a diagnosis of a serious mental illness
- Not enrolled in:
 - Long-term Services and Supports (LTSS);
 - Community Living Assistance and Support Services (CLASS);
 - Deaf Blind with Multiple Disabilities (DBMD);
 - Home and Community-based Services Waiver (HCS), or
 - Texas Home Living Waiver (TxHML), or
 - STAR+PLUS HCBS Waiver
- Have income that does not exceed 150% of the Federal Poverty Line

LONG-TERM PSYCH. HOSPITALIZATION

- Resided 3 or more years (cumulatively) in an in-patient psychiatric hospital
- Medicaid eligible

JAIL DIVERSION

- 4 or more arrests and 2 or more psychiatric crises during the 3 years prior to referral
- Active Medicaid benefit

EMERGENCY ROOM DIVERSION

- 15 or more Emergency Room visits and 2 or psychiatric crises during the 3 years prior to referral
- Active Medicaid benefit
